Random Drug Testing Responsibilities and Acknowledgment

As a condition of release, you have been ordered to submit to random urine testing at the direction of U.S. Pretrial Services. U.S. Pretrial Services conducts its own on-site drug testing program to monitor the condition of release ordering that you "refrain from any use or unlawful possession of a narcotic drug and other controlled substances, defined in Title 21 USC 802, unless prescribed by a licensed medical practitioner."

To find out when to submit a urine specimen, you have been assigned a color, which is _____ . You will call the color line daily at:

(602) 322-7350 (or 1-800-769-7609 outside the Phoenix area). You will hear a recorded message announcing the assigned color(s). If your color is announced, you shall report to U.S. Pretrial Services to submit a urine specimen between the hours of **8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Your assigned color will remain the same until it is changed by your supervising U.S. Pretrial Services Officer.

After **4:00 p.m.** the recording will announce the color for the **following** day. Please pay attention to the color announced, as well as the day. The instructions for Monday's tests will be provided beginning **4:00 p.m. the Friday before.** It is necessary that you call every day.

Should the phone system fail to function properly, you need to report the following day for a test. If you are unable to report for a test for any reason, you are to notify your U.S. Pretrial Services Officer immediately.

You are to notify your U.S. Pretrial Services Officer of any medications you are taking, including over-the-counter and prescription drugs. You are **NOT** to take any medication that is prescribed to another individual. You are **NOT** to take any medication prescribed in a foreign country.

The urine specimen collection procedures are as follows:

You will be required to submit a urine specimen of approximately 45 ml. Of urine. This is a bottle which is three-quarters full. Should you fail to provide a sample in this amount, this will be considered a stall. Your U.S. Pretrial Services Officer will be informed. If you are unable to submit a sufficient sample amount and leave the premises to drink water, a second specimen collection bottle will be used. Both urine specimens will be used in the testing process.

Any specimen suspected of being altered shall be forwarded to laboratories for testing, and the Court shall be informed if adulteration is confirmed. If adulteration is suspected, you may be asked to submit a second sample the following day.

After you verify the urine specimen being collected, labeled, and sealed is your urine specimen, you shall sign the label, affix it to the bottle, and sign the chain of custody form.

If your urine specimen tests positive, you refuse to submit a urine specimen, or you fail to report as required to submit a urine specimen, a report will be submitted to the Court outlining the violation of your release conditions.

I have read this document and fully understand all requirements and responsibilities. I agree to abide by the above-mentioned requirements and procedures.
